ABOUT THE OSHKOSH DEFENSE NGDV PROGRAM

- The Next Generation Delivery Vehicle (NGDV) program represents the United States Postal Service's (USPS) first large-scale fleet procurement in three decades.
- 2 Oshkosh won the competitively <u>awarded</u> contract in February 2021, which allows for the delivery of between 50,000 and 165,000 vehicles over a period of 10 years.
- 3 Oshkosh can produce any mix of BEV and ICE vehicles, up to 100% BEVs, that the USPS wants.
- The vehicles will include the modern safety and ergonomic features carriers deserve, such as a driver airbag, front and rear automatic braking, superior direct visibility, low step in heights, 360-degree camera system, air conditioning, adjustable mail trays and large door openings.
- On June 22, 2021, Oshkosh Defense <u>announced</u> it will manufacture the NGDVs in their Spartanburg, South Carolina factory. Facility preparations in South Carolina are well underway and <u>hiring</u> of team members has already begun.
- 6 Production of the next generation delivery vehicle is expected to begin in 2023.
