Oshkosh Defense Statement on JLTV A2 Contract Announcement

On February 9, 2023, the U.S. Army announced the winner of the Joint Light Tactical Vehicles (JLTV) A2 program. We were disappointed to learn the government's decision.

As the original manufacturer, only Oshkosh's JLTV proposal leveraged substantial JLTV experience and established infrastructure, while providing best-in-class upgrades to the JLTV platform. Oshkosh was first awarded the JLTV contract following a competitive evaluation in 2015 and has delivered more than 19,000 vehicles and 3,500 trailers date. Under the current contract, Oshkosh can deliver vehicles through September 2025. Our current backlog calls for production through 2024.

Oshkosh remains committed to designing and delivering the world's most capable light, medium, and heavy tactical wheeled vehicles for the U.S. Armed Forces now and for many years to come.
