Earlier in his career, he was a founding member of Insitu, a pioneer in unmanned aerial systems, which was later acquired by Boeing. He also held leadership positions at IBM Corporation.

Mr. Nordlund serves on the boards of trustees for Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University and Whitfield School. He holds a bachelor's degree in aviation management from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University and a master's degree in business administration from the University of Florida.
